DESCRIPTION AND APPLICATIONS

The Electro-Voice Model 307A suspension shock mount adapts to boom use any microphone having a cylindrical ³/₄-inch diameter case. It may be attached directly to a microphone boom or floor stand.

The 307A shock mount permits quick installation or removal of a microphone without tools. A molded plastic support grips the microphone snugly and is supported by two molded neoprene shock cords to provide maximum isolation from shock.

The Electro-Voice Model 307A shock mount assembly can be boom- or stand-mounted to provide shock isolation for the CS15P, DO56, RE10, RE11, RE15, RE16, RE18, RE55, 635A, 635A/B, 649B, or other microphones having cylindrical 3/4-inch diameter barrels.


REPLACEMENT PARTS
