**DESCRIPTION AND APPLICATIONS**

The Electro-Voice Model 805 contact microphone is designed to pick up, for external amplification, music from a guitar, banjo, or any other string instrument having a sounding board. Vibrations of the instrument on which it is mounted are transformed into faithful electrical replicas of the instrument's true sound.

The Model 805 microphone is supplied with a 15-foot single conductor shielded cable and a convenient spring clip which permits attaching the microphone to the instrument without tools or additional hardware.

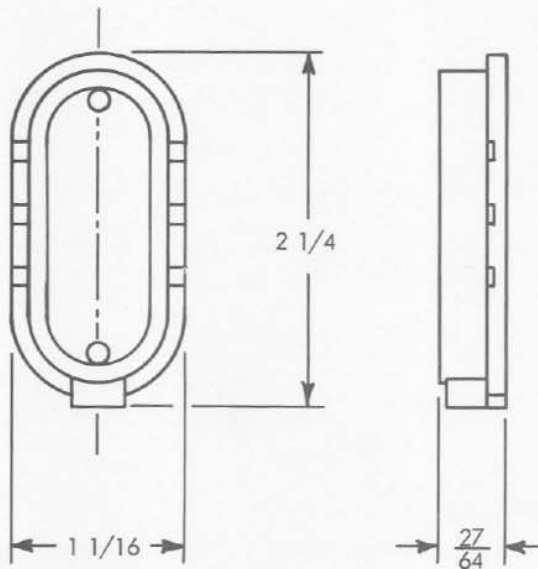


Figure 1 - Dimensions

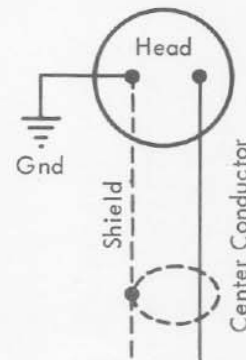


Figure 2 - Wiring Diagram
