

DESCRIPTION

The UPI-10MB mounting bracket kit consists of a 10-gauge, cold-rolled-steel U-bracket, two friction pads, two washers and two Torque Knobs. The kit is specifically designed for wall or ceiling mounting of the UPI-10 and UPI-10T speaker systems

The UPI-10MB allows each system to rotate around its enclosure mounting centers, permitting angular adjustment after mounting. Two Torque Knobs bolts are included to stabilize the system in its final position. Although simple in design, the UPI-10MB allows the UPI-10 speakers to be mounted in almost any position so as to obtain the desired sound coverage.

WALL MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Refer to Figure 1 for the following steps.
- 2. Remove the paper backing from one of the friction pads (C) and attach to the U-bracket (A) as shown. Be sure the two 1/4-inch holes are aligned. Attach the second friction pad in a similar manner.
- Attach the U-bracket to the wall or ceiling using fasteners (not supplied) that are suitable for the construction material.
- Remove the two plastic hole plugs from each end of the UPI-10 or UPI-10T speaker by gently prying with a small screwdriver.
- 5. Place a washer (D) on the threaded stud of each of the Torque Knobs(B).
- Mount the UPI-10 or UPI-10T speaker to the U-bracket using the Torque Knobs and washers. Do not tighten.
- Rotate the speaker so that the input panel is accessible and attach the wires to the input panel.
 Position the speaker for the desired coverage and gently tighten the Torque Knobs.
